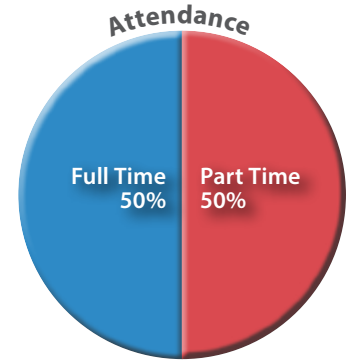
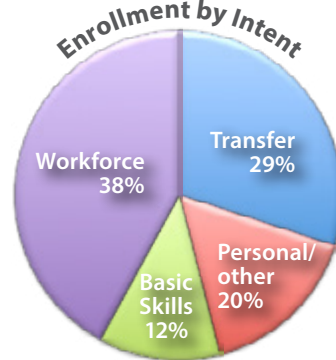

49% of full-time students graduate or transfer within three years; higher than the average of our peer institutions.

42% of full-time students of color graduated or transferred within three years.

Within One Year of Graduating:

53% of Academic Transfer graduates transferred to a four-year school.
